Monsoon weather forced a cancellation of the planned Healing Crusade in Prescott Valley on August 3. We plan to pick up the schedule in June 2020.

A Navajo Nation rally in August

brought a full house in Chinle, Arizona. Pastor Artie Aragon is continuing his powerful work in several tribes in America and Canada.

The annual Oceanside, California Crusade was a powerful testimony of salvation and miracle healing despite the shifting of venues due to construction at the usual beach location.

The Zwolle, Holland Conference/Tent Crusade in Rotterdam showed evidence of the aggressive evangelistic efforts of the Dutch churches.

Pastors Greg and Wayman Mitchell led a Men's Rally in London for Pastor Nigel Brown, with great impact and enriching ministry for European pastors.

Pastor Wayman Mitchell followed up with ministry in the Melbourne, Australia Conference for Pastor Darryl Elliott. A new church in India and a new work in New Zealand resulted. A quick one-day trip to the Sydney churches for Pastor Rob Walsh's Conference saw three pioneer churches planted.

The Phoenix, Arizona crusade for Pastor Gary Marsh brought a good number of souls as well as many miracle healings.

In between these a quick stop in the Chandler Bible Conference, the McAllen, Texas Rally and a memorial service for Pastor Lee Wilson in Albuquerque, along with a crusade in Farmington, New Mexico filled out the quarter.

Hello from South Central El Paso, TX. My wife and I moved to El Paso in April 2019 to pioneer.

We started doing park concerts, home Bible studies, and church in the park with people responding almost immediately.

**K**ia ora, greetings from Victory Church Murupara, New Zealand. God is doing great things in this small township.

Murupara is a town located in the North Island of New Zealand. As of the last New Zealand census held in 2017, the official population is 1,780 persons, made up predominantly of the Maori indigenous people of New Zealand.

Murupara was once a thriving town. Employment particularly in forestry was plentiful and at its height, the population had grown to over 5000 in the 1960s. But things changed in the mid-1980s. With the privatization of the logging and forestry industries, many jobs were lost. Families that were able to, made the decision to move and overnight, Murupara became a ghost town.

The town has continued to struggle ever since. There is currently a heavy

gang presence with two of New Zealand's largest and rival gangs having taken up residence immediately after the town's collapse.

Today, Murupara, once known for its beautiful surrounds rich with hunting and fishing opportunities has the unfortunate reputation of being a crime-riddled community dominated by generations of gang culture and historical reliance on the benefit system.

At the Perth Conference in March 2019, Pastor Graham Thomas and his wife Teresa, along with their two children were launched out of Victory Church, Rotorua, to pioneer a new work in Murupara.

The community has welcomed the new addition with open arms which is a miracle in itself as it is the kind of community that is very suspicious of "out of town" people.

God opened a door for Pastor to work in the social/youth sector where

responded to the altar call and at the night concert 26 further souls were added to the Kingdom of God.

Our opening service was held the following day Sunday, May 5. There was victory and an awesome testimony of God's grace as 14 visitors attended our first church service. From that first service, two families have continued to attend to this day.

Since the first service, there has been a formation of a core of faithful saints that attend both daytime and night services. Even in this cold winter period, we are seeing an adding of people to the church.

God has also blessed the church with generous tithers and givers. The young people make up impact teams and help surrounding Fellowship churches.

As this victory report is being drafted, the church is preparing for its first water baptism. We are looking forward to seeing younger and even older congregation members taking the next step in their walk with God and deciding to be water baptised.
