Hello from Prescott! The weather is warming up, and we are beginning to transition our outreaches outdoors!

To start, We just wrapped up a powerful week of revival with Evangelist Glen Puglesi from El Paso, Texas. We kicked off our revival week with a Youth Rally. Over 200 young people from Fellowship churches around the area, Phoenix, Glendale, Casa Grande and as far as Las Vegas, NV drove to be a part of the rally.

As we met at the church, Evangelist Puglesi shared a challenging message to the youth, a message of strategy and direction for our young people. A challenge was given to usthis generation of young people, saved by the power of God, as the hope for this broken generation. We headed out in outreach excited and emboldened with the anticipation that God would use us.

One highlight of the outreach was a group of young girls who had never been on an outreach before. They were filled with excitement and a desire to tell everyone they met about the good news of the Gospel. Watching them share their testimonies for the first time was super encouraging.

During the outreach they were speaking with a woman who had a medical condition that caused her a lot of pain, and she was facing surgery. These young girls, bold and believing in the Power of God, asked if she believed God would heal, and said she did believe, and would be willing to allow them to pray for her. They were able to lay hands on her and pray for her healing. It was so encourag-



ing to know that even as young kids, God could use them in mighty ways. The entire day was a fruitful day of evangelism in which we saw 33 souls saved and two people healed.

That evening we put on a new Production, led by Pastor Jesse Morales, called "A Super Fairy Tale." The production offers a simple story involving some of the most loved princesses and superheroes. There is a clear Gospel message through the production.

The play makes an impact in drawing out families and young people, and afterwards we allow for pictures with all the beloved characters. At the end of the night we saw many many visitors and nine souls saved, and we are excited to continue to hold showings of the play throughout the summer.

Following the Youth Rally, we had a week-long revival that was a powerful time. Evangelist Puglesi contended for deliverance at every altar call, and many timely words were given. The revival saw many miracles of healing, and testimonies of God's deliverance in our congregation. We greatly appreciated the ministry of Evangelist Puglesi and God's faithfulness to meet

with his people.

Following the Revival we kicked off summer outreaches. Many of the young disciples in our congregation have had the opportunity to hold outdoor outreaches and healing crusades. These healing crusades, often held in someone's front yard or a local park have been able to make an impact on local neighborhoods and families. We have seen many miracle testimonies of healing and fruit from these outreaches.

Delbert John, one of the disciples in our church, had the opportunity to lead a healing crusade. As we evangelised and outreached in preparation for this event, there was a lady who saw a flyer and called Delbert. This lady was bedridden and unable to leave her house due to severe back pain. She asked if Delbert would be willing to pray for her during the healing crusade, even though she would not be able to attend. Knowing that we serve a God who is a miracle worker, and is not limited by location, Delbert agreed. During the healing crusade he called this woman, and led her in a

Greetings from Barstow, California.

We are excited to share how God is moving in our city!

Last year was a great fight to remain open and as many of you know many things were cancelled or put on hold, and the biggest setback was that we were under orders to close the doors of our church.

That all changed after members of our church attended Winter Conference. As the saints heard the testimony of what God was doing in other states and cities we were challenged and compelled to outreach!

Even though we were still under stay-at-home orders we decided to step out in faith, and we got a little creative in our outreach efforts. My ammonia level has never been under control. I was hospitalized at 220, and 160 was my normal, lowest was 130. Normal is 20. Well, my doctors test showed my level was 20. Praise God! He gas done a great healing in my body.

Thanks to God and the faith of Evangelist Ballinger, I am healed. The doctor asked what I did differently. I said I went to a revival and got prayed for and God healed me. He kept on looking at me trying to figure it out. He said to keep doing whatever I was doing. I don't need pills or insulin!

Many more were touched and

healed.

This will be a great year for our Fellowship...let's continue to believe God. This is just the beginning!

In the midst of the 2020 lockdown


the church had its best year ever financially. As California is finally opening back up we're going out again with the band, drama and impact teams.

because she did not want her baby to repeat the cycle of having an addict for a parent.


Miguel continued to use drugs; he was also involved in criminal activity. He was set up by one of his cousins, and sliced in the face, head, and chest with a machete. He almost died but was revived by the paramedics. He continued in his addiction.

Fast forward to nine years later and three more kids. Rose was at her wits end with life. She was so tired of life and the way it was going. She was the one who was holding down the fort working, taking care of the kids and trying to give them a better life. Miguel was so bad in his addiction he was robbing houses and stealing cars just to pay for the drugs.

Rose knew there was a God and that asking Jesus for forgiveness of sin was her only hope. She would pray every night for forgiveness for the way they were living and for God to help Miguel before he ended up dead in a ditch or in prison for life.

Miguel was in and out of jail, and he called Rose begging to get bailed out because something was wrong with his stomach. He was experiencing severe abdominal pain and stated throwing up blood. The nurses just told him it was constipation. He was finally bailed out and as he was walking to the store to use the phone he collapsed on the street and was takin to the hospital by the ambulance.

Miguel's appendix had ruptured, and the poison was throughout his organs. He had emergency surgery and was fighting for his life for six days. Finally the fever broke, and he was released. At home that night Rose and Miguel started talking about the "what ifs" that could have been if he had passed away. Miguel finally realized he needed to change, and Rose was relieved that maybe this was the turning point in their lives. They started talking about going to church, and that they should go to the one down the street because they saw a sign

about a Christmas event.

Miguel said he did not want to just show up to a church, that the only way he would go is if he was invited. As Rose was thinking how she could make this happen, there was a knock at the door. As she opened it there was a man standing there who said he was Pastor Steve, and started asking about the people who used to live there and that they used to go to his church. He held out a flyer and invited them to a Christmas play at the Potter's House.

Miguel and Rose stared at each

other shocked, saying that they were literally just talking about being invited to a church. Miguel asked Steve what brought him to the house, and he said he was driving in the area and God put it on his heart to follow up with that house.

Miguel and Rose gave their lives to Jesus that night at the Christmas play, on December 2013. Miguel had to go to prison for his crimes and during that time Rose backslid. In December 2014, when Miguel was released, they both started to drink, and things were taking a turn for the worse. There was a new pastor at the church who tried to get in contact with them, but they were running from him.

In November 2015, feeling convicted by their children, Rose and Miguel went to a concert that they saw advertised on Facebook about their church. They have been faithfully attending since, and God has continued to move in their favor. God has blessed them both with good paying jobs and they have bought a house, something they thought was not possible. God is doing a tremendous work in their lives, they are rising up in ministry and are faithful servants in this congregation.

Testimony: Nery Ayala-Hernandez

I thank God for my salvation. I have battled addiction on and off for more than 20 years. During my addiction I suffered homelessness, domestic violence, depression, even attempted suicide; I also lost my children to CPS living in homeless shelters. As a kid growing up my parents would take us to the Catholic church. Thinking back now I never truly learned anything about how amazing my God truly was/is.

I've experienced death three times in my 42 years of life.

The first time I was so broken and depressed with nowhere to go. I had just gotten my kids taken from me by CPS and placed with family. I found myself in the hospital for extreme anemia. I was passing out

in public places such as the CPS office. I ended up in a hotel room alone. I was tired, sick, depressed, I just wanted to go to sleep and never wake up. But I woke up to the paramedic making me swallow black charcoal to empty my stomach. Turns out I had taken a whole bottle of sleeping pills with alcohol. By the grace of God housekeeping found me unresponsive and called 911.

The second time I had just had my son in an emergency c-section and I was bleeding out. I had to have a hysterectomy to save my life. The third time I was active in my addiction. I thought I was only using meth. Turns out they had mixed it with ecstasy! I overdosed and still to this day I vividly see how my own eyes were watching my lifeless body on the medical gurney.

So I truly believe God is not done with me yet. He has restored my family and got my kids back. I was blessed to marry my soul mate in December of 2018 in our church, and he has delivered me from my addictions. My God placed me exactly where he needed me and around three years ago he brought me to the place I would call home full of loving individuals who accept me for who

I am. He gave me the best church family I never thought I could have. My life isn't perfect but it does get better every day and as long as my God is leading my way I won't get lost again.

Testimony: David Hernandez

Bound into darkness was an understatement for me.

From the day I was born I was raised in a home where severe domestic violence, alcoholism, and drug abuse was a daily occurrence.

My mother and father were "older generation Mexicans," and even though they tried the best they could, they could not keep these curses from being passed down to me.

I started using alcohol and drugs at a very young age (around 13), and getting into major trouble with the law. I started noticing I was different from my other peers in that fact that as I grew older, the sins became more and more heavier and darker. I became involved in dealing drugs (and of course using them), violence and criminality. Prison and jail were a norm for me. But at this point I was only a shell of a person. I was broken. I did everything backwards to the point where I thought I was cursed.

Every time I thought things couldn't get worse, a new low would come. My family had given up hope on me. My own mom would tell everyone that she knew that I was no good and that I was going to kill someone and end up in prison for the rest of my life. I myself had given up on life. I decided right there that the world and my family was better off without me. I wanted to die and I contemplated suicide.

Every attempt to get the right program, self help modules, or my own will was met with failure. Even though it was evident that my lifestyle of drugs, violence, and sin had taken everything from me I was never able to get it out of my heart. The world would always call me back into the grip bring me to a place that was worse than before.

Then I found myself in a dingy

jail cell way up in Northern California, broken hearted. The cops had beat me up, and I was facing a whole new list of violations and felonies. I got down on my knees in the middle of the jail cell with tears streaming down my face. I cried out to God to teach me how to love Him. I told Him that I hated my life and that I needed help!

I pleaded with God to surround me with people who would show me how to live for him, to literally hold my hand in this process because I didn't know how - but knew in my heart this was the only way there would be a glimmer of hope for my life.

I got out of jail and a few months later attended The Potter's House in Blythe Ca. Right away, Pastor Neal started inviting me to have coffee with him and the brothers from the church and allowed me to do small jobs around the church. Today my life has taken a complete 180. I've dedicated myself to try and make it to every service and function that I could. Let me tell you that God has not only answered my prayers to the "T" but has completely restored my life more than I thought possible.

I got married in the church in December of 2018 and God has given my wife, my children, and me a whole new family in Christ. He has restored a peace and joy in my heart that I had never felt before or that I thought was possible for me.

God has even put in my heart to be a disciple under Pastor Neal and it has been such a blessing. God has kept me and made me His and indeed snatched me away from the enemy's camp. Every desire to go back to my old sin has completely gone. The local Drug Rehab Center was following my progress through the grapevines and decided to offer me a position at their facility.

I thank Pastor Neal and his wife and my church family for helping me to live for God but most of all I thank God for hearing my prayers that day and bringing me out of the darkest pit. If you are out there and you need God to do a miracle in your life, don't give up because he did it for me.



We have more than tripled over the last nine months with our largest service only two weeks ago! We have seen more salvations in the past nine months then the last nine years put together, God had been helping us immensely.

We have done a very small amount of advertising and almost all the visitors have been word of mouth, people bringing people. The church is excited and grateful that the door is open and they are able to attend on a regular basis

We have had regular men's meetings every month along with local pastors preaching, including Dale Ramsey who came and ministered the Gospel. We saw miracles and God moved in peoples' lives.

In our city and province the government had arrested three pastors to date. This has done nothing more than put a fire under the people in our church and has made them more hungry for the Gospel. My father was a good man. People loved him, They enjoyed his company. He was a musician who played in a band. He would often be the life of the party, singing and playing his guitar, bringing joy to people. But my father had his faults...

He worked a job, he lived from week to week. Sometimes he would get paid and go straight to the pub after work. He'd spend all of his money on alcohol and gambling, leaving nothing for my mother and their six kids at home. We struggled to survive. His bad habits brought a strain to the family, and sometimes would hit my mother. But because he was our father, my family still loved him.

When I was two years old, my father died. Our family was distraught. My mother who was pregnant at the time had a miscarriage due to the stress. My uncle came and lived with us to help support her, but he was an alcoholic, and it led to my mother drowning her sorrows in alcohol as well.

I witnessed so many parties at our house and violence at home. At the age of four years old, I would wake up after



my house and one of the disciple's houses with one couple from church only. They take turns coming to church, but they have to invite a new couple. We have added three new couples to church through this and these couple are locked into the church and on fire for God. They are already making decisions to one day go out and preach the Gospel!

a party had finished and everyone had gone home, and drink some of the leftover alcohol. I ended up being a "trouble kid," having a police record at the age of seven.

At 13 years old I'd be jumping out the window, taking off to parties, doing drugs, getting with girls, getting up to mischief and taking off for the whole weekend.

I got suspended and then got kicked out of school. At 18 years old, I had no qualifications, no future, and I was on the dole. At 20 years old, I moved to Australia and worked in a bar. Those days were filled with clubbing, friends, drinking, gambling, drugs, girls and I loved it. But my pleasures soon became my problems. I lived from week to week. I would get paid and go to the clubs straight after work with all my mates, and spend all my money on gambling, drugs and alcohol, leaving no money to live on. I was also physically abusing my partner at the time. I soon became jobless, homeless and with no hope.

My sister told me about Jesus and how He could help me. I prayed a sinner's prayer and invited Jesus into my heart and life. Ever since then, Jesus took all of my addictions away. I no longer crave all the addictions I once had, nor the life I once lived.

I am saved and a born again Christian. I am a Bible study leader in my local church. I use my story to help others overcome their problems. I am married with two kids and have recently started a transport company.

I am so grateful for Jesus saving me, helping me, and blessing me. Now I can do the same for others.

Pastor Ricky Paramio and his family witnessed how the Burmese people have a deep spiritual thirst that only God's Word can quench, so he continues to meet with them and minister to them online. Please pray for Myanmar.

This first week of May, we just concluded our biannual Bible Conference themed "The Pattern of our Fathers." We were refreshed and blessed by the very timely ministry of the Word by Pastor Tom Payne, Pastor Jesse Cluck and our local pastors. Although there were still some restrictions, an average of 200 people were in attendance every morning and evening. The conference highlight was the Friday night announcement of seven local pioneer works and a couple taking

over the church in Taipei, Taiwan.

We continue to praise God on what He has done here for the past six months. We also thank Pastor Greg Mitchell for this opportunity to give our report. God bless our fellowship! we've also seen so many saints from dozens of other cities and nations being blessed by our Livestreams also.

In our past two conferences, October 2020 and April 2021, we were able to announce a total of 16 national churches and two international churches, one being in the USA and the other to the nation of Argentina!

The most recent victory took place in May, where we had a total of 47 new converts baptized, which is most definitely something that the Nogales church has never seen.

Three days later, we bid a fond farewell to pioneer missionaries Jaime and Georgia Cruz. We were left with some gigantic shoes to fill (I think Jaime is a size 13), as the Cruzes had labored fervently for five years raising up this solid work.

November and December were ROUGH! Alright, January was rough, too. Panama was under weekend lockdowns, plus daily 7 p.m. curfews. Due to the number of cartel-related deaths in the neighborhood, a police checkpoint was set up directly in front of the church.

Lisa and I were never flagged down, though (they just rolled their eyes and waved us on). I think it's because we don't have that "packen heat" look (Lisa thinks it's because we DO have that senior-citizen-missionary look). All in all, it had been a few months, and we still hadn't gotten to know some of the congregation (well, not in person, anyway).

But God has a plan! Even with all the strictly-enforced restrictions in place, people began to come in out of the cold (figuratively speaking), and moreso after the easing of the Sunday lockdowns.

One brother in the church approached me with an idea: Could we have cake and ice cream after service, so he could tell his family that his birthday would be celebrated at church this year? He offered to take care of everything, and let everyone know that it was a church service, with a celebration following.

We had more than 25 people in our "25 percent capacity" building (I'm pretty sure our maximum seating is probably 100...). At least four people prayed for salvation, and some of the visitors came to service that next Sunday! The brother continues to bring his siblings, nephews and grandkids to church, sometimes making two trips.

These are little victories that will add up to greater victories, not only here in the mission field, but anywhere the Gospel is being preached! Don't give up!

We are from the Waipahu, Hawaii church with Pastor Daniel and Jodee Jones, launched out from the Prescott summer conference of 2019.

What a wild journey it has been pioneering a church through the season of global pandemic! Nothing happened the way we envisioned it as we relocated to this part of the world.

With the COVID mitigation policies of Spain and the national state of alarm, we had to figure out creative ways to get the Gospel out. Social media has been a way to connect with those who started coming out, but nothing has coffee and a Bible study. But even as we pressed through the strictest stretch of the national state of alarm, God has always pointed us in a direction and given us opportunities.

We received a word from Pastor Scott Lamb when we were launched out: "God's going to open doors for you. He's going to bring you into relationship with people. The key is going to be he'll introduce you to a man here and a man there and they are going to open doors into whole sections of the community. They are going to be the contact points and as you move with them, they are going to introduce you again and again, it's going to multiply and multiply and multiply, so you just follow God's leading as He leads you through these men and don't be afraid to step through any door. Don't be afraid to step through the doors God opens because he's going to open amazing doors before you. You're going to see it happen and you're just going to go, 'Wow, look what God has wrought!""

To this point, it has happened exactly as the word was given. We have amazing favor with the American community. Our first convert, who is from a U.S. naval command, started bringing his shipmates to the services. Since he relocated, others from his
